# 4. Principal/Vice Principal Reports

- Salish staff will be meeting with the grade 7s on February 14th to help them with grade 8 course selection.
- School admin is looking into booking an Art Starts program/performance for the school this year. Staff have said we haven't done it in a few years. The organization offers the School District a grant that goes towards the fee, but it still usually costs about \$800-\$1000. Schools have typically booked two of these a year, and they allow us to expose children to other "fine arts" that are typically not taught in the classroom. Ms. Keeper will submit a request of funds form to PAC, voting to approve the funding will take place at the February meeting
- Book fair brought in more than \$2,000 in profits for the library. Ms. Chapman is very grateful for all the support she received from the parent volunteers.
- The school is looking to replace the original volleyball standards. It is \$900 for the pair, plus taxes and delivery fees. PAC will confirm if this can be covered under the school's gaming funds.
